- 2 PUBLIC SESSION
- 2.1 Chairman Suspended all Standing Orders for members of the Public to address the Council Proposed 1st Cllr M Budge 2nd Cllr C Marshall. A resident addressed the Parish Council with concerns regarding the amount of rubbish which has been left at the back of the Village Hall and rubbish being left in the football Car Park by the developers working nearby. It seems the developers are leaving their rubbish and is being blown about around Lynher Close. One resident has attempted to address this issue with the Site Manager with no avail, therefore, Clerk to contact the Agent to see if this can be sorted. Cllr Parsons will also look into this matter. It was also reported to the Parish Council cars are being driven around the football pitch and as a result of these above issues, proposed 1st Cllr D Daniells 2nd Cllr M Stephens and all agreed by Clirs that a gate will be installed at the entrance of the Car Park up to 12ft and will be looked if necessary. At the back of the Village Hall are 5 bags of excess plaster and bricks from a demolition. The Clerk will contact Cornwall Council and report "Fly Tipping". No further residents addressed the Parish Council and Standing Orders reinstated proposed Cllr M Budge 2nd Cllr C Marshall.

#### 6. REVIEW OF CLERKS REPORT

- 6.1 <u>St Torneys Church Graveyard Ms C Latham introduced herself and apologised for the confusion regarding the Church Graveyard, and would like give an update. The old Graveyard around the Church is closed and this is now the responsibility of Cornwall Council. The new Churchyard which is still being used as there is space for those from the local community, this Graveyard is the responsibility of Lewannick and North Hill Church, and would welcome any help with grass cutting or financial aid. The New Parish Gaveyard is the responsibility of North Hill Parish Council. Ms Latham will continue to keep the Parish Council informed of the Closing of the Church.</u>
- 6.2 <u>Hymn Sheets</u> Hymn sheets which have been re-typed have been proof read by Rev J Smart and Cllr M Budge and both are happy for this to go to print. Clerk and Cllr M Budge to meet on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> October at the printers. Cllrs wish to ask Mr M Jenkins of Halwell Farm to lay the wreath at this years' Service, if Mr Jenkins is unable to committee Cllrs wish to ask Mr E Gribble. Cllr M Budge to purchase wreath

- 6.5 <u>Village Hall Committee Tree in Car Park</u> It has been suggested to the Parish Council that as the Tree is interfering with electricity wires, Hi Line will carry out the works need free of charge. Clerk to look into this.
- Attendance to Parish Council Meetings The Chairman addressed the Parish Council and requested all Clirs must inform either himself of the Clerk if they are unable to attend a Parish Council meeting. The Chairman also stated that if a Clir misses more than 4 meetings consecutively, Clirs will be advised by letter from the Clerk that if attendance is not made the Parish Council will ask the Clir if they would like to continue to be a Clir as all Clirs are summons to attend Parish Council meetings.

# 7. REVIEW OF CORRESPONDENCE

- 7.1 Sale of Land Adj to Football Pitch Mrs Yeo and Mrs Provis have accepted the terms on which the Parish Council have stated and therefore, the Chairman will arrange a meeting with Cllrs, Kivells, Mrs Yeo and Mrs Provis to have the land re-registered with the correct measurements and submitted to the land register to enable progress with this matter.
- 7.2 <u>Cornwall Council Affordable Housing</u> An email has been received from Cornwall Council offering help and advise for those wishing to provide Affordable Housing in their Parish.
- 7.3 <u>High Street Fund</u>—A Grant is available from Cornwall Council to help with maintaining the area. The Parish Council will look into this as money would be helpful for North Hill Litter Pickers and other items.
- 7.4 CCC Working Group for Climate Change The Clerk has received several emails and letters regarding the decision on which Cllrs made at the last meeting referring to the Climate Change Emergency. Mr K Thame addressed the Parish Council on behalf of several residents (see notes attached). Residents wish the Parish Council to declare this emergency, and feel let down by the decision made. Councillors stated that they are indeed in favour of supporting this declaration, but as individuals do not have the time to commit to extra meetings and therefore felt they could not support.
