1. RECEIVING APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

2. <u>PUBLIC SESSION SUSPENSION OF STANDING ORDERS FOR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO SPEAK</u>

2.1 Chairman suspended Standing Orders for Members of the Public to Speak Proposed 1st Cllr R Hudson 2nd Cllr S Sandercock. No members wished to address the Parish Council. Standing Orders reinstated.

5. REVIEW OF PLANNING APPLICATIONS

- 5.1 <u>PA22/00602</u> Proposed extension and remodelling. 3 Blacksmiths Meadow Coads Green Launceston Cornwall PL15 7FF Councillors do not object to this application as it is not invading privacy of the neighbouring properties. Proposed 1st Cllr S Sandercock 2nd Cllr S Maher with all Councillors in favour. Cllr Parsons and Ruby Abstained.
- PA21/09812 Conversion of existing barn into annexe and holiday let Kingbeare Barn North Hill Launceston Cornwall PL15 7NT Cllr M Budge declared an interest Cllr R Randall conducted the meeting. A site visit was held on 12th February 2022 to view the development and found that the elevations are "back to front" e.g., West should be East etc. with this in mind the property does not overlook neighbouring properties therefore Parish Council are satisfied their queries and proposed 1st Cllr R Hudson 2nd Cllr S Sandercock with all Councillors in favour. Cllrs Ruby and Parsons abstained. Cllr Budge returned to Chairing the meeting.
- 5.3 PA22/00855 Minor revisions to planning permission no. PA10/06968 (construction of book storage building) including the partial use of timber cladding to two elevations and increasing

the width of the footprint by 500mm without compliance with Condition 2 of decision notice PA11/10768 dated 14.02.2012. Mill House Mill Lane Bathpool Launceston Cornwall PL15 7NW Councillors would like to make a site visit for 22nd February at 5pm to view the development. Clerk to arrange with proprietors.

- 6.1 <u>Kompan</u> Cllr Randall has got no further forward. PlaySafety Inspections are to be contacted to cancel the up-and-coming Play Area inspection.
- 6.2 <u>Community Network Schemes</u> "Expressions of Interest must be submitted to your Cornwall Councillor, Highways Manager and Community Link officer (copying in Nicky Drewett) by Monday 28th February 2022." Councillors wish to request "Flashing Smiley Faces" for Coads Green to help prevent speeding through the Village which are to be located near the school entrance and entrance of Coads Green from Congdon's Shop.
- 6.3 <u>Plusha</u> An accident occurred at Plusha during Christmas and New Year and as a result Cornwall Council want to close the Centre Point on the A30. However, it is felt by Councillors from all Parishes that this Centre Crossing just needs to be improved. North Hill Parish Council are in support Altarnun Parish Council, Lewannick Parish Council and Chris Sims for the improvements.
- 6.4 <u>Congdons Shop</u> The Clerk has contact Launceston Police to request a Speed Check at Congdons Shop. The response from PCSO Ross "I have visited Congdon's shop there is really no-where safe enough to stand to do a speed check. Also, the 40mph signs are so close to the junction there it would not be legal to do checks from the crossroads towards Coads green."
